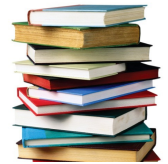
Nga mihi o te wa kia koe me to whanau (Greetings to you and your family)

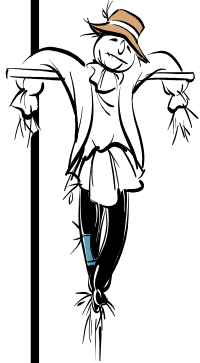
