'Mid Year' Mini Report Issued 23 June

At the end of next week students will be issued with the usual mini report to take home to you. The intention of the mini report is to give you an indication of how your child's teacher sees their achievement/effort in reading, writing and maths at this stage of the year.

It may also be the spur for discussion/ clarification at the next week's conference.
