Last Saturday:

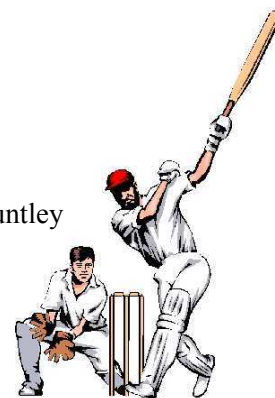
