## CLASSROOM FOCUSES

Room 1 Mrs Hatfull	<p>Reading – we are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Relate picture to print</li> <li>• Look at pictures as clues to meaning</li> <li>• Control directionality left to right pointing with left fore finger.</li> <li>• Re-read to gain meaning</li> <li>• Point to each word at the beginning of each word</li> <li>• Handle books correctly</li> <li>• Recognise capital letters and fullstops</li> <li>• Know: picture, text, cover, letter, word first letter, last letter, top of page, bottom of page, story.</li> </ul>
Room 2 Miss Viles	<p>Maths – we are learning to solve addition and subtraction problems by counting all objects in our heads. By counting back in 1's, 2's, 5's &amp; 10's.</p> <p>We are learning to solve addition and subtraction by using tidy numbers. I.e. <math>29+33= 30+32=62</math></p>
Room 3 Mrs Spencer	<p>Maths – Number: we are working on our multiplication and division knowledge and strategies at our maths stage (3,4,5,6).</p> <p>Reading: we are learning to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• retell parts of a story (narratives), beginning, middle, end.</li> <li>• Use the sentence and story line to help us work out the meanings of words and phrases.</li> </ul>
Room 6 Mr Johansen	<p>Writing – We are learning to do proper planning of our writing and proofreading</p> <p>Maths - WALT find and solve number patterns and make our own</p> <p>PE - WALT use inside of foot</p>
Room 7 Mr Smith	<p>Mathematics: Room Seven will be moving on to a addition, subtraction, multiplication and division revision unit. In this unit they will be learning a variety of strategies to work out problems.</p> <p>English: Room Seven are learning to improve the quality of their writing by looking closely at their sentences, paragraphs and the way they edit their work.</p>
Room 8 Mrs Dalley	<p>English: We are revising grammar, sentence and paragraph structure, to improve the quality of our writing.</p> <p>Mathematics: We are revising area, circumference, perimeter, and learning to find the volume of 3d shapes. Next we will be working on using protractors effectively to measure angles.</p>
