<p>Room 7 Mr Smith</p>	<p><b>Mathematics:</b> Room Seven are learning to develop an understanding of different types of graphs to display data. <b>Reading:</b> Room Seven are learning to read for fluency and understanding through a variety of fiction texts.</p>
<p>Room 8 Mrs Dalley</p>	<p><b>English:</b> We are learning to write persuasive texts to convince the reader to believe our ideas.
